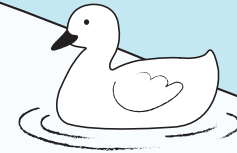
Did you know?



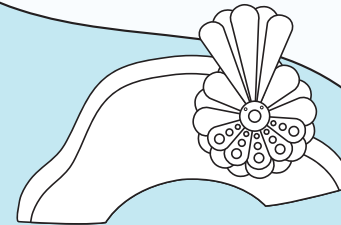
- 1 The Bittern (or butterhump as it's known in Norfolk) has a booming call that can be heard over two kilometres away.
